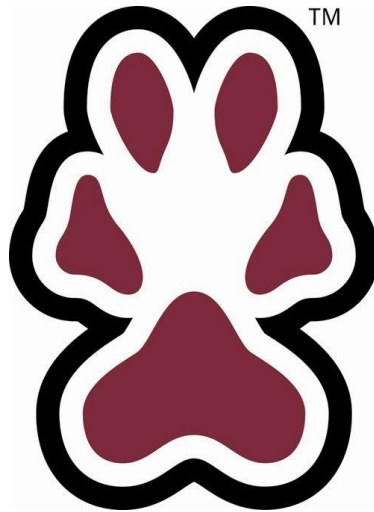

Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in The Student Programming Council (SPC). Being selected as a member of the 2017 SPC Board of Directors is an honor full of important responsibilities and traditions. We applaud your desire to seek out this exciting opportunity. In an attempt to gain a wider perspective of your qualifications, we require that you fill out this application and submit a letter of recommendation from faculty, staff, or supervisor.

In order to qualify to be interviewed and be selected for this position, it is required that as an undergraduate you are a currently registered student, enrolled in at least 6 credit hours, have a current cumulative grade point average of 2.30 or higher, as well as be in good standing, both academic and disciplinary at SIU Carbondale. As a graduate student you must be currently registered as a student, enrolled in at least 3 credit hours, have a current cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or higher, as well as be in good standing, both academic and disciplinary at SIU Carbondale. You should be able to demonstrate that you have had direct experience with programming and knowledge of appropriate resources. It is important that you have the ability to motivate student volunteers and work with other students, faculty, staff, artists and agents. If selected for the position, your training will begin immediately and your term will continue through December 2017. If you wish to continue in your position after that time, you may reapply. This is the second round of interviews. *Films Director is the only position available at this time.*

The complete application and recommendation form are due no later than 4:00PM on Friday, February 17th in the Office of Student Engagement, located on the 3rd floor of the Student Center. Upon submitting your application and recommendation form, you are required to sign up for an interview time slot. Interviews will take place on Tuesday, February 21st between 4:30-6:30pm.
